Jerry Patrick send us his helping tool for preparation of the rowers seats:

At right is the jig for cutting the seats. Insert a 1x4 from right as shown, between two guides strips, until it touches cross strip. Use fine saw for exact length and true 90 degree angle.

The jig at left shows guides for 2x2 strips, inserted from left to right. This strip has first been marked along entire length with the distance between seats. There is a rectangular space where the modeler places tiny drop of glue, then places the seat. When dry, push it out to the right and repeat.

I hope this is clear. It was a big help to me and I hope will be to others.

Half the fun of modeling is having to invent tools and techniques.
